WINTER CAMP POSITIONS

KORISH:

Qualifications: Attendance at two or more previous Winter Camps. Previous Winter Camp leadership experience. Active Brotherhood membership in the Order of the Wimachtendienk. Approval by the IWS.

Description:

- 1. Selects Winter Camp staff with the approval of the IWS.
- 2. Directs and coordinates staff.
- Arranges transportation for humans and properties to and from Winter Camp.
- 4. Reports directly to the IWS.
- 5. Prepares final report of Winter Camp.

PRIMARY CENTRICS:

Qualifications: All Primary Centrics will have previous attendance experience at Winter Camp. They should be at least Brotherhood members in the Arrow. They are appointed by the Korish with the approval of the IWS. Description: This inner circle of leadership will report directly to the Korish. Each Primary Centric will direct a staff in a specific area of responsibility. He will appoint Secondary Centrics as necessary for specific areas of his responsibility. The Primary Centrics will join the Korish at the inner table for meals.

PROGRAM PRIMARY CENTRIC:

Description:

- 1. Directs Winter Camp activity program.
- 2. Directs library, museum, and archive operation.
- 3. Directs religious and philosophy program.
- 4. Directs training and education program.

INNER ENVIRONMENT CENTRIC:

Description:

- 1. Directs food preparation and service operation.
- 2. Coordinates health and safety program.

OUTER ENVIRONMENT CENTRIC:

Description:

- 1. Directs building and grounds maintenance program.
- Directs property acquistion and distribution operation.
- 3. Directs camp service detail.
- Directs internal and external finance operation.

SECONDARY CENTRICS:

Qualifications: All Seconds will be selected by the Primary Centrics for specific areas of responsibility, with the approval of the Korish and IWS. They must be Arrowmen able to conduct normal respiratory activities.

Description: Seconds may be appointed for such responsibilities as head cook, properties manager, librarian, head custodian.

TERTIARY CENTRICS:

Qualifications: Terts will be selected by Seconds for the various tasks in the operation of Winter Camp. Terts must have successfully completed birth.

Description: Terts will be directed to perform such duties as cooking, janitorial services, activity functions, etc.

COMMUNICATION CIRCLES

PRIMARY: These direct arcs of authority and communication will exist between the Korish and the Primary Centrics.

No intervention of Seconds or Terts will be tolerated.

SECONDARY: These arcs of authority curve between the Primary Centrics and their outerline Seconds. Primary Centrics do not have direct communication with Seconds outside their own spheres of influence.

TERTIARY: These fundamental command arcs exist between the Seconds and the Terts.
